

RELIABILITY IN APPROVAL OF DANGEROUS GOODS EXPORT REQUESTS

The container shall be authorised to enter the port precinct before the expected date of arrival of the truck at the terminal.

Scope of the commitment:

- Containerised cargo loaded for transport by sea by the Port of Barcelona at the following terminals: APM Terminals BCN (APMT) and Barcelona Europe South Terminal (BEST).

Points to keep in mind:

- The exporter shall send the shipping instructions with information on the Dangerous Goods no later than 09:00 on the business day before the day requested for entry. If additional documentation is required, it shall be sent before 15:00 on the business day before the day requested for entry.

Compensation if the commitment is not met:

€150 per request

Exclusions:

- Cases where the shipping company cancels or delays the stopover, or the container is not loaded during the planned stopover, all the above on grounds of force majeure.
- The commitment does not apply to Dangerous Goods passing through the Port for the first time, if these goods are not listed on the safety data sheet or the APB database.
- Containers in cabotage with the Balearic Islands.
- Explosives (IMO-01) and radioactive substances (IMO-07).
- Cases where the commitment is not met on grounds of force majeure.
