

PUBLICATION OF BERTHING DOCKS AND CRUISE TERMINALS

For cruise traffic, the Port of Barcelona undertakes to publish berthing docks 30 calendar days in advance and Terminals 15 calendar days in advance on its website.

Scope of the commitment:

Cruise ships that fall within the scope of the integrated stopover request procedure (PIDE).

Points to keep in mind:

- The publication date will be referenced in relation to the expected time of arrival (ETA).
- The shipping agent shall request the stopover with the notice period established by APB.
- This provision may be subject to change.
- For charter services, the terminal may be announced earlier.

Compensation if the commitment is not met:

€80 per stopover

Exclusions:

- Cases where the request was made after the pre-defined date will be dealt with on a case-by-case basis and the dock will be assigned according to availability.
- Cases where confirmation of the Stopover (DUE) was provided by the shipping agent less than 75 calendar days prior to the requested ETA.
